

BR White Double Arrows

Full size/application details are provided below.

Class 31 Original Railfreight Grey, Red stripe
Class 37 Original Railfreight Grey, Red stripe
- 12.0mm width: Class 47 InterCity Executive
Class 47 ScotRail
- 10.0mm width: All classes, Standard Blue Livery
- 8.5mm width: dependent on specific loco rather than class. 8.5mm width is also principal size for multiple units and coaching stock eg DBSOs

F4300 Double arrow motifs in white - mainly small

- 8.5mm wide: 8 pairs
- 10mm wide: 8 pairs
- 12mm wide: 5 pairs
- 24.5mm wide: 3 pairs
- 32mm wide: 1 pair

F4300 Double arrow motifs in white - small

- 8.5mm wide: 14 pairs

F4301 Double arrow motifs in white - mainly large

- 24.5mm wide: 1 pair
- 30.5mm wide: 2 pairs
- 34mm wide: 1 pair
- 35.5mm wide: 2 pairs
